ack Faust Matlock was US Ambassador to the Soviet Union from 1987-1991. This collection includes materials rom him and his wife, photographer Rebecca Matlock, dating largely from the 1940s through the mid-2010s. The bulk of items relates to their work for the US Foreign Service; they were officially stationed in Washington Moscow, Prague, Accra, Dar es Salaam, and Zanzibar and traveled extensively throughout the world. Jack Matlock was a key figure in the Ronald Reagan administration and participated in almost every US-USSR ummit from the 1970s until his retirement in 1991. Also present in the collection are diaries, writings, nemoranda, reports, clippings, interviews, photographs, event files, audiovisual materials, and other locuments regarding the Matlocks' career, travels, interests, family life, and scholarship.
